

# 2007 Annual Report of Sports Medicine Chapter of Hong Kong Orthopaedic Association (HKOA-SMC)

In the year 2007, HKOA-SMC has been growing, in terms of our number of members, our activities, and our achievement. This is a result from the conjoint efforts of all our members, council members of HKOA-SMC, as well as the supports from the council of HKOA. I am summarizing all our activities in the year 2007 as followed:

## I. Members of HKOA-SMC

According to the council of HKOA 2007/2008, the biennial subscription fee for our members for the Chapter has been raised from HK\$100 in 2005/2006, to HK\$200 in 2007/2008, with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007. Having increased the fee of individual chapters, the number of members of HKOA-SMC has been growing from 40 members in 2006, to around 60 members in 2007.

## II. Regular Tri-monthly meeting

Our regular tri-monthly scientific meetings have been carried out on the last Tuesday of every 3 months, in QEH, with details as followed:

## III. Educational Courses:

1. HKOA-SMC has run several arthroscopy surgery courses in the year 2007, as well as collaborating with other parties in running several scientific congresses,

HKOA-SMC essentially works as a supporting organization for the last 3 events and bare no responsibilities for the budget & the finance. For the “Autologous Chondrocyte implantation workshop”, there is a net profit of ~HKD350.

2. HKOA-SMC has worked with HKCOS to run educational activities for all our fellows and members, including hosting the Saturday inter-hospital meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> June 07 & 1<sup>st</sup> Sept 07, as well as teaching in the Saturday tutorial for our trainees.

3. HKOA-SMC has worked with HKCOS to run educational activities for our publics, including working out educational information pamphlets about Knee, Shoulder and Ankle injuries, as well as providing script and information on “Ski injuries” for HKCOS PIC group.

#### IV. Collaboration with Industrial parties

In the year 2007, HKOA-SMC has been working with a few industrial companies in supporting Educational activities for our members, summarizing as followed:

##### 1. Bangkok Arthroscopy Course

With the supports of Arthrex Int. & Health Medical Company Ltd., 7 of our members are partly supported to attend Shoulder/Knee arthroscopy course in 2007, held in the Chulalongkorn University of Bangkok, Thailand. All of them are guaranteed a place and the course fee (US\$400) is waived. This will be carry on in the year 2008.

##### 2. HKOA Best Paper Award for Sports medicine & Arthroscopy section

With the supports of Smith & Nephew Company, a HKOA Best Paper Award for Sports medicine & Arthroscopy section has been set up for 2 consecutive years in HKOA annual congress (i.e. in 2007 & 2008). This is designed to award the best oral paper presented in the Sports Medicine & Arthroscopy section of the HKOA annual congress, and the award is in form of supporting the winner to attend a overseas arthroscopy course, covering the air-ticket, course fee and accommodation, altogether not more than HKD\$15000. In the year 2007, Prof Marc J Phillipon & Dr. Paul Tse are the invited judges for the said competition.

V. Financial report:

In the year 2007, the only activities that has financial commitment from HKOA-SMC is the “Autologous Chondrocyte implantation workshop” held on 29<sup>th</sup> June 2007, with a net income of ~HKD\$350.

VI. Planning in 2008

1. HKOA-SMC will be a supporting group as a co-organizer of the 5<sup>th</sup> World Congress of Sports Trauma & The 6<sup>th</sup> Asia-Pacific Orthopaedic Sports Medicine Chapter, to be held in the Postgraduate Education Centre, Prince of Wales Hospital, on 11-13<sup>th</sup> April 2008. This is an event mainly organized by the APOSSM as well as the CUHK-WHO Collaborating Centre for Sports medicine and Health Promotion, and thus HKOA-SMC bares no responsibility on its budget and finance.
